- **FREE Cyber Hygiene (DHS):** Free DMZ vulnerability scanning and trending for SLTT MS-ISAC Members; I can send a sample out if we have a government only list.
 - DHS also has free pen test and risk assessment, but expect a 6 month
- **FREE Daily Alerts and Monthly threat briefings:** Again I can share examples if we have a gov't only list.
- **FREE Weekly Malware IP/Domain Report to block:** I can share a sample
- **FREE Incident Response:** 24/7 hotline, advise, also FREE forensics analysis via FTP Imaging or sending the drive, they have a nice SOP.
- **FREE Monitoring for your domain** (i.e. cuyahogacounty.us): monitors for past bin, accounts leaks on forms, dark web, **twitter**, etc.
